- Key Signature:** One sharp (F#)
- Time Signature:** Common time (C)

- Trills:** Indicated by *tr* above notes in many parts, including the woodwinds and strings.
- Percussion:** The Tamburo (snare drum) has a trill-like pattern in the first measure, and the Gran Cassa (bass drum) provides a steady accompaniment.
